Possible Hurdles to Registration

- **Incomplete pre-requisites**(a course that is required before the course you want)
 - Show proof of pre-req taken at another college or university to the appropriate educational department --OR--
 - Take pre-requisite shown in [Catalog](#)
- **No Accuplacer or ACT/SAT Test Scores**
 - Show test scores to Testing Center or take Accuplacer
- **Holds listed on your account**
 - Check my.ppcc.edu and then go to appropriate office
- **Instructor Permission Only classes**
 - Get paper registration form from Enrollment Services or CP&A
 - Get instructor signature and return form to Enrollment Services

Placement Assessments

Colorado Requires Accuplacer Assessments for Math, English and Reading unless you have . . .

- *Earned Associate's Degree (AA or AS) or higher*
- *Successful completion of college-level English*
- *Successful completion of college-level Algebra or higher*
- *Previous assessment at a Colorado public post-secondary institution.*

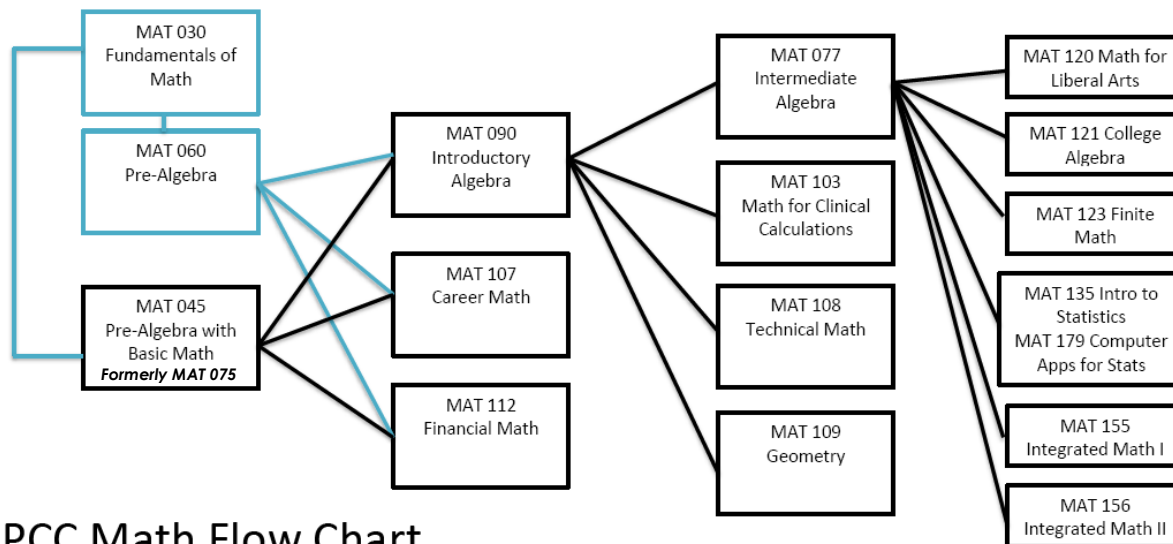

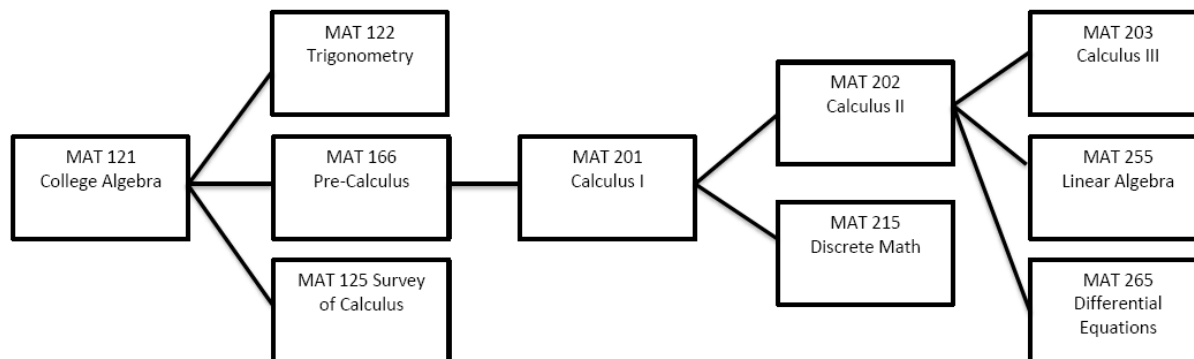


Math Pathways
