What is gtPATHWAYS?

To help eliminate the guesswork of transferring general education course credits, Colorado has developed a statewide guaranteed transfer (gt) program. gtPATHWAYS is a set of general education courses that the state guarantees to transfer to all Colorado public institutions of higher education.

What courses are guaranteed to transfer?

Up to 35-37 credits of approved general education courses taken at a Colorado public college or university are guaranteed to transfer among all two- and four-year institutions. And, if an AA or AS degree is completed at a community college, 60 credits of community college coursework will transfer, upon admission, to a four-year college or university, where students will arrive with junior standing.
