All applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Currently to be an active participant in Coach Eddie Hughes' Multicultural Male Retention Program.
- Must be male AND be a minority (Black, Hispanic, Asian, Pacific Islander or Native American).
- Completed at least 12 credit hours of 100+ level courses at PPCC by August 2009 and intend to enroll in at least 9 credit hours in the Fall 2009 Semester.
- Be classified as a "nontraditional student" by meeting **one or more** of the following classifications:
 - Be at least 19 years old and/or have at least a one-year gap between high school graduation and PPCC enrollment
 - OR be a GED recipient
 - OR be a former foster care youth
 - OR have previously been in the juvenile justice system
 - OR be active duty military
 - OR be a former military member
 - OR be intending to pursue EMT/paramedic training
- Commit to completing an associate's degree or a technical certification at PPCC.
- Commit to participating in a formal mentorship program with a community mentor.
- Commit to being a mentor to a group of Multicultural Male Retention program students and to being a role model for your peers.

If selected, in order to continue to receive this scholarship, recipients must:

- *Maintain at least a 2.0 GPA*
- *Demonstrate progress towards academic and career goals*
- *Attend at least two of Coach Eddie's events per semester*
- *Actively participate in mentoring programs, both with community mentor and peer mentees*
- *Remain enrolled at PPCC*
