Criteria for the Daniels Scholarship

1. Must be a graduating senior at a Colorado Springs alternative or charter school.
2. Must enroll in a **transfer program** at Pikes Peak Community College (PPCC) **and intend to go on to a four-year college or university after graduation.**
3. Must be enrolled full-time at PPCC.
4. Must complete a FAFSA on-line at www.fafsa.ed.gov even if you are not eligible for federal aid.
5. Must submit an essay of no more than two pages (one page if typed) addressing the following:
 - A. What you hope to achieve
 - B. How the scholarship will change your life
 - C. How the scholarship will help you to better your community
6. Must submit an unofficial high school transcript.
7. Must maintain at least a 2.0 cumulative GPA ("C" average) in order to keep the scholarship.
