



Larry Young Memorial Scholarship

The Larry Young Memorial Scholarship was established by the Pikes Peak Sales Professionals International through the Pikes Peak Community College Foundation in memory of **Dr. Larry Young** who was a veterinarian and mortgage broker in our community for over 30 years. The scholarship will provide \$500 to a PPCC student who intends to enroll in the Fall Semester, 2009. This scholarship will be awarded to a student who has the same drive for entrepreneurship that Dr. Young possessed. Applicants must currently own their own business **OR** plan to own their own business after graduating from college.

Dr. Young was known for his quiet dignity, sharp mind, and dry, engaging humor as well as his love for people and active community involvement. He built Ridgewood Animal Hospital and helped found Central Animal Hospital. Later, he transferred those skills and aptitudes to the mortgage industry, where he assisted hundreds of families in purchasing homes. Dr. Young was the founding president of Prestige Mortgage of America. He invested himself in his community as a member of Pikes Peak SWAP (Salesmen with a Purpose), now called Pikes Peak Sales Professionals International. This group's purpose is to promote free enterprise and entrepreneurship, motivate and train sales people, and foster friendships and camaraderie.

For more than ten years, Dr. Young was a member of the Austin Bluffs Sertoma Club, in which he served as president. The mission of the Sertoma Club is service to mankind. Larry was an active member of First United Methodist Church where he served in a variety of volunteer capacities. He enjoyed helping youth in the local 4-H organization and was an avid outdoorsman and hunter. He was a passionate, giving person who loved his family deeply.

This scholarship is given in the hope that it will help a student who has the same drive for entrepreneurship that Larry possessed. Selection of the recipient for the Larry Young Memorial Scholarship will be done under the following guidelines:

- Applicants must own their own business **OR** plan to own their own business after graduation.
- Applicants must have at least a 3.0 grade point average. (Please attach your most recent transcript to your application.)
- Applicants must write an essay in which they state their career goals and future objectives. This essay should be no longer than two pages double-spaced. (Please attach the essay to your application.)
- Applicants must agree to attend a 7:30 a.m. breakfast meeting with the Pikes Peak Sales Professionals.
