# Instructions for the PPCC Foundation Scholarship Award Application

Each year, the Pikes Peak Community College Foundation provides over \$100,000 in scholarship awards to PPCC students who are not eligible for Pell Grants, or other aid that covers full tuition and fees. (Students may, however, receive partial aid from other sources.) The scholarships, generously provided by individuals and/or corporations in our community, assist students with the cost of tuition and fees for one (academic) year at PPCC. The amount of each scholarship is \$850 for full-time (12 credit hours or more), \$425 for half-time (6 credit hours), and \$212.50 for quarter-time students.

## Applicants Who Have a Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.75 or Above:

Applicants who have a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above have, by far, the best chances for being selected to receive a scholarship. You must be classified as a Colorado resident by the PPCC Admissions Office. Applicants who have a GPA of 2.75 or above do not need to submit an essay.

### Requirements:

1. Application submitted by May 29th for the following academic year
2. Transcript attached to application (most recent high school or college)
3. FAFSA form completed on-line at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). You must complete the FAFSA even if you are not eligible to receive federal or state aid. This enables the Financial Aid Office to distribute funds equitably. (Attach proof of submittal, i.e., copy of confirmation of submittal page.)

## Applicants Who Have a Cumulative Grade Point Average Lower Than 2.75:

There are a limited number of scholarships available for applicants who have a cumulative grade point average below 2.75. You must be classified as a Colorado resident by the PPCC Admissions Office. Applicants who have a GPA lower than 2.75 must submit an essay.

### Requirements:

1. Application submitted by May 31 for the following academic year
2. Transcript attached to application (most recent high school or college)
3. FAFSA form completed and determination letter attached to your application, if you get it back in time. If not, submit your application without the determination letter. The FAFSA form is available in Enrollment Services or on-line at [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov). You must complete the FAFSA even if you are not eligible to receive federal or state aid. This enables the Financial Aid Office to distribute funds equitably.
4. A letter or essay attached to your application. This letter or essay must convince the Selection Committee that you are passionate about your educational goals, and that you will maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above in your classes at PPCC. Finalists in this category may be required to attend an interview with the Selection Committee.

**NOTE TO ALL APPLICANTS:** If you are selected to receive a scholarship, you must maintain a cumulative grade point average of 2.75 or above in order to continue to receive it. If you have any questions, call 502-2016. Return all application materials to:
