

Transcript of Welcome Video

Hello students! This video will give you general information about the STEM Fellows and Writing Fellows Programs and how you can participate.

First, what are the STEM Fellows and Writing Fellows Programs? These programs are interactive, hour-long group tutorials run by Fellows tutors who work for the PPCC Learning Commons.

STEM Fellows supports MAT 121, BIO 111, and CHEM 111 courses.

Writing Fellows support writing intensive courses including English, history, psychology, sociology, and other courses.

In these sessions, the Fellows tutor will give you tips, tricks, and resources about the session topic or subject as well as giving you time to practice your skills with students in the session. Make sure that you bring your course materials and your questions to the session.

For the Fall 2020 semester, Fellows Programs will be offered online through Zoom. Links for the sessions will be available on the Learning Commons website or provided by your instructor.

Just click on the link on the day and time of the session you plan to attend and follow the prompts. You can check out our Student Guide for Fellows Programs Online for more help about accessing the session and how to use Zoom.

The schedule for STEM Fellows and Writing Fellows sessions are also available on the Learning Commons website.

For STEM Fellows, check the schedule for when sessions for specific courses will be offered.

For Writing Fellows, session topics rotate every week, so check the Session Topic Description Guide and the schedule for when deciding what sessions you want to attend.

You can attend as many sessions as you like. However, your instructor may ask you to attend specific ones. The only requirements are that you attend for at least 45 minutes and that you participate during the session. It's okay if you're late within 15 minutes of the start of the session. And if you need to leave early, just let the Fellows tutor know.

At the end of the session, you'll receive a link for a survey. We encourage you to fill out this survey; please let us know how the session went for you!

And finally, STEM Fellows and Writing Fellows Programs are designed for learners at all skill levels. We are here to help you!
