College campus “traffic flow” can be confusing. One way streets, lots of pedestrians, no parking, reserved parking, and speed limits, can all present challenges for people who are not familiar with our campus. Coupled with the fact that many of our visitors are relatively inexperienced drivers anyway, we have an abundance of reason to be cautious while on our grounds. Centennial

- **New Traffic Flow for E-Lot:** You may now ***enter*** E-Lot from the Bus Stop Area. Previously, you could only exit there. Note however, that you can no longer exit E-Lot that way.
- **Speed Limits:** 25 mph on Perimeter Road, 15 mph by the Child Development Center, and 10 mph in the parking lots.
- **South Service Road Parking:** Reserved for persons with State issued Handicap plates/placards and delivery vehicles. You may not create your own parking areas next to the Breckenridge Bldg., even if you work / teach there.
- **A-Lot Parking:** Reserved for visitors and restricted to one-hour. If the spots reserved for Adjuncts are occupied, you must find alternate parking in C, D, or E - Lots. You may not simply take one of the Visitor spots.
- **Exiting Centennial:** If you need to go north on I-25, please exit the college at the western exit (traffic light in front of the flag pole). This will allow you more space to negotiate the two lane changes necessary in order to turn left onto I-25.

Rampart

- **TCA Traffic:** Our partners with The Classical Academy block the western approach to RRC (off Cross Peak View) during their morning and afternoon rush hours. It's best to simply enter and exit on the eastern side.
- **Speed Limits:** 25 mph on Perimeter Rd, 15 mph by the Child Development Ctr, and 10 mph in the parking lots.
- **Four Way Stop:** There is a lot of pedestrian traffic on the west side of the campus, near Lots 3, 4, 5, (around the CDC and TCA Center). Accordingly, we enforce the 4-way stop at that intersection.
- **Motorcycle Parking:** The easternmost edge of Lot 2 contains narrow striped spots for motorcycles. Four wheeled vehicles are not permitted to park there.

Down Town Studio

- **Parking:** Both the East and West Lots are reserved for employee and handicapped (including handicapped students) parking. Students should use the Antlers Parking Garage. Employees who can't find parking in the East and West Lots should also use the Antlers Parking Garage. When the Antlers Garage is full, arrangements have made to use the Commercial Lots on both the north and south sides of the Phantom Canyon Restaurant at the corner of Cascade Avenue and Pikes Peak Avenue.
