The Kane University Connections Scholarship - for students who plan to transfer to UCCS for a bachelor's degree

The Kane Associates Scholarship - for students who plan to join the workforce after completing the associates degree

WHO CAN APPLY

- Class of 2022 high school seniors.
- GPA of 3.25 GPA or higher.
- Starting at PPCC in Fall 2022.
- Ready to take college level courses at PPCC.
- Plan to be a full-time student at PPCC, taking 12 credits or more a semester.
- Must complete degree at PPCC in four semesters.
